**AN ORDINANCE** appropriating \$7,553.00 from the undesignated fund balance of the 2020 Park Fund in acceptance of easement and processing fees from the City of Kansas City, Missouri, and authorizing the County Executive to execute a Permanent Sewer Acquisition Agreement and Permanent Sewer Easement in favor of the City of Kansas City.

**ORDINANCE NO. 5330, May 4**, 2020

INTRODUCED BY Crystal Williams, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the City of Kansas City, Missouri (the "City") desires to realign and replace a failed section of existing sewer line within the County's Blue River Parkway, as part of the City's Citywide Sewer Infrastructure Rehabilitation Within Waterways Project; and,

WHEREAS, the City has requested that the County grant a permanent sewer easement over a portion of the parkway for this project; and,

WHEREAS, the requested easement is 27,766.2 square feet in size, containing 0.64 acres, and will require the closing of a hiking trail during construction activities; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Parks + Rec has recommended that the County execute the attached Permanent Sewer Acquisition Agreement and Permanent Easement in favor of the City for this project; and,

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to pay the County easement and processing fees required by the Jackson County Code, totaling \$7,553.20; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is needed to place the City's funds in an appropriate spending account to be used for park purposes; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation from the undesignated fund balance of the 2020 Park Fund be and hereby is made:

The Smart Sewer Program (SSP) is undertaking a Design-Build project to reduce excessive inflow and infiltration by rehabilitating sewer infrastructure, including manholes and sewer pipes buried beneath or immediately adjacent to, or exposed in natural waterway channels. The sewer jnfrastructure is experiencing excessive inflow and infiltration due to the age of the infrastructure, close proximity to the streams, and damage from exposure.

Rehabilitation of sewer infrastructure will also include elements of stream stabilization, bank stabilization, sewer CIPP lining, manhole armament, realignment of sewers and manholes, and encasement of exposed sewer pipes to stabilize sewer infrastructure to protect against stream migration and hydrodynamic forces.

There are multiple sites that are being rehabilitated this project year within the City limits of Kansas City, Missouri. Site 28 is located approximately 1,100 feet East of the intersection of E 118<sup>th</sup> Street and Lydia Avenue. This location is along an existing sewer in a North/South orientation along the Blue River on Jackson County Parks & Recreation property. MH S195-005 is exposed in the Blue River and sections of pipe are also exposed south of MH S195-005. The designed improvements will abandon MH 195-005, encase the exposed sewers with concrete and CIPP line the existing sewer.

We are requesting the attached access easement to facilitate construction and future maintenance. We understand and agree to the acquisition agreement attached.

# PERMANENT EASEMENT FOR WASTEWATER IMPROVEMENTS AND APPURTENANCES

That, Jackson County, Missouri hereafter called the GRANTOR, on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, for and in consideration of \$1.00, the receipt of which is acknowledged, does grant, remise, release and forever Quit-Claim unto Kansas City, a Missouri Municipal Corporation, whose mailing address is:

and hereafter called the **GRANTEE**, a **Permanent Easement** for the location, construction, reconstruction, maintenance, and repair of wastewater improvements and any appurtenances thereto, over under and through the following described tract of land situated in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, to-wit:

#### LEGAL DESCRIPTION ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT A

The GRANTEE, its agents, employees or independent contractors shall have the right to go upon the above described tract of land, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and repairing the wastewater improvements and appurtenances thereto, and shall upon completion of such construction, maintenance or repair, cause the land of the GRANTOR to be restored to substantially the same condition that existed prior to the GRANTEE'S entry upon it.

The GRANTOR herein agrees for itself and its heirs, successors or assigns, that the tract of land over which a permanent wastewater improvement easement is being granted shall be kept free from buildings or any other structures or obstructions (except grass, shrubs, fences, sidewalks, roadways, pavement or curbs) that would interfere with the GRANTEE in excavating upon said permanent easement for the purposes of laying, constructing, operating, maintaining or repairing storm water infrastructure and all appurtenances incidental thereto.

The GRANTOR herein also agree for itself and for its heirs, successors, or assigns, that the earth cover will not be increased without the written approval of the GRANTEE'S Director of Water Services.

These easements shall not be construed to prohibit the **GRANTOR** from developing any adjoining property or from the laying out, establishing and constructing of pavement, surfacing of roadways, curbing and gutters along, upon, over or across said easement or any portion thereof.

GRANTOR further states that it is lawfully seized of title to the land through which said easement is granted, and that it has good and lawful right to convey said casement to the GRANTEE herein.
