REQUEST SUMMARY	MoDOT has determined that the intersections of 7 highway and Stringtown and County Line in Jackson County are in need of improvements. The improvements will add turn lanes and improve sight distance to reduce accidents. MoDOT has prepared preliminary plans for these improvements which include work on the side intersecting roads which are County owned roads.  MoDOT has requested that Jackson County enter into an agreement covering the work to be accomplished on the side roads and execute a deed transferring existing county right of way to MoDOT. The agreement states there is no cost to Jackson County for any of the planned work. MoDOT plans to accomplish the work in 2021. 7 Highway will have reduced speed and lane closures during the construction.  The Public Works Department has reviewed the plans with MoDOT and recommends the County Executive be authorized to execute the agreement and the deed on behalf of Jackson County.
