SUMMARY	Institute for the following purpose:						
	The Stowers Institute for Medical Research, a scientific research facility in Jackson County, is						
	in the process of developing an automated version of the Centers for Disease Control's PCR-						
	based test for SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19. The Institute's automated						
	version is expected to require significantly less labor than manual versions of this test. The						
	Stowers Institute intends to apply to the Food and Drug Administration for Emergency Use						
	Authorization for its automated method. The authorization may be received	as early as the					
	fall. The Institute will not be offering testing services to the general public to share the protocol for its automated method with other interested parties	and instead wishes in Jackson County.					
	In order to share its protocol broadly, the Institute needs to obtain immunity from liabilit						
	claims. Immunity is provided under the federal Public Readiness and Emergency						
	Preparedness Act (the PREP Act) and the national emergency condition est	ablished by the

The Institute proposes to enter into the attached Memorandum of Understanding with Jackson County, Missouri to cover the Institute and any other parties interested in using the automated method. With the MOU in place, Jackson County would be able to provide its authorization to interested parties, referred to in the MOU as Operators. Operators that use the county's authorization and the Institute's automated method would be able to provide testing services to residents and organizations in Jackson County with the protections available under the PREP Act.
