	This project is a pilot collaboration between the Jackson County Prosecutor's office, Swope Health Services Behavioral Health Program, and Morningstar Development Corporation. The collaboration will provide substance use disorder (SUD) treatment services on an outpatient basis to meet the needs of individuals struggling with substance use disorders. Referrals will be forwarded by the Jackson County Prosecutor's office.						
	The Jackson County Prosecutor's Office has over 60 cases for charging that are substance abuse cases. Subsequently, the impact of the arrest on the individual may have subsided and the motivation to address the substance use disorder diminished. This effort will address these cases in a manner that is equitable and treatment oriented.
