COMBAT desires to expand the services provided by First Call of Kansas City. The proposed expansion will include the implementation of a *Grant Application Submission Software*; the creation of the *Prevention* and the *STRIVIN Functionalities* and their data *Migrations*; and *Custom Reporting features*. Annual maintenance is also included in the proposed costs. These proposed enhancements will allow, in a single system, greater electronic documentation of services performed, client demographic data and program reporting and outcomes. The application submission and management system will allow agencies to electronically respond to funding opportunities and enable COMBAT staff to better maintain and manage applications.
