THIRD ADDENDUM LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

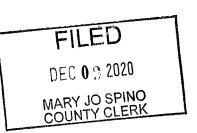
WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Legal Counsel has entered into a Legal Services Agreement dated May 19, 2019, whereunder Legal Counsel agreed to provide specialized legal advice and representation to the County relating to certain state court litigation involving the Rock Island Rail Corridor, lawsuits styled *Groh v. Jackson County, Missouri*, Case Number 1816-CV00401, and *Morris v. Jackson County, Missouri*, Case Number 1916-CV10539, and other related matters; and,

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to increase the maximum sum available for services rendered under this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, County and Legal Counsel respectively promise, covenant and agree with each other as follows:

Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the Legal Services
 Agreement dated June 19, 2019, between Legal Counsel and County shall remain
 in full force and effect.



- 2. The maximum sum to be paid by County to Legal Counsel shall be increased by the amount of \$13,000.00 for a new maximum total of \$361,000.00.
- 3. The Third Addendum shall be effective as of August 1, 2020, and shall remain in effect, together with the previous Agreements, until December 31, 2020.
- 4. This Third Addendum to Agreement together with all previous Agreements. incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.
