REQUEST SUMMARY	This ordinance appropriates \$195,000 in CARES Act funding to address the needs of Jackson County's domestic violence shelters that have been brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic. This ordinance allocates \$65,000 to Hope House, \$65,000 to Newhouse, and \$65,000 to Rose Brooks. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and in order to comply with CDC and local health department guidelines for social distancing, the shelters have had to significantly reduce the capacity of its shelters. To counteract this reductions shelters have begun sheltering survivors in hotels. This funding would help the shelters to continue doing this, and assist clients with past due rent, utility bills, housing application fees, and other housing needs. This funding will also allow the shelters to be reimbursed for the necessary cleaning supplies to keep facilities sanitized and personal protective equipment for staff and clients; support expenses related to the hotel placement programs; and address survivors' evolving needs through case management.
