INTRODUCED BY Jeanie Lauer, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Medical Examiner's Office desires to continue to participate in the tracking program sponsored by the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, for statistical reporting of opioid and violent deaths; and,

WHEREAS, the office's participation in this program was originally authorized by Resolution 19732, dated February 12, 2018, and has been reauthorized since then; and,

WHEREAS, under a proposed Amendment to the Agreement, the County will be reimbursed for providing reports of opioid and violent deaths through August 31, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$31,300.00; and,

WHEREAS, the attached Amendment to the Program Agreement sets out the rights and obligations of each party participating in the program; and,

WHEREAS, execution of the attached Amendment to the Agreement with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services is in the best interests of the health, safety,


and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,



AMENDMENT #01 TO CONTRACT #KQ200047823

CONTRACTOR: Jackson County Medical Examiner

CONTRACT TITLE: Violent Death and Overdose Death Surveillance

CONTRACT PERIOD: September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2021

The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services hereby exercises its option to renew the above referenced contract.

In addition, the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services desires to amend the contract as follows:

1. Delete paragraph 1.1 in its entirety and replace with the revised paragraph 1.1 as follows:
 - 1.1 The contract amount shall not exceed \$31,300.00 for the period of September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2021.
2. Add paragraph 2.5 as follows:
 - 2.5 To avoid the Contractor needing to fill multiple record requests from various DHSS programs, MOVDRS and OD2A staff may share information provided by the Contractor with other internal DHSS programs. Records of such data sharing can be provided to the Contractor upon request.
3. Delete paragraph 5.1 in its entirety and replace with the revised paragraph 5.1 as follows:
 - 5.1 The Department will pay the Contractor a firm, fixed price of \$30 for each submitted complete MOVDRS case and upon approval of all required reports and invoices. The total amount for all MOVDRS cases shall not exceed \$9,000.00.
4. Delete paragraph 5.2 in its entirety and replace with the revised paragraph 5.2 as follows:
 - 5.2 The Department will pay the Contractor a firm, fixed price of \$30 for each submitted complete OD2A case and upon approval of all required reports and invoices. The total amount for all OD2A cases shall not exceed \$4,800.00.

All other terms, conditions, and provisions of the contract shall remain the same and apply hereto.

This contract is entered into by and between the State of Missouri, Department of Health and Senior Services (Department/state agency) and the below named entity/individual (Contractor).
