SUBJECT: 2020 Vehicle Lease Contract, Request for Proposal NO. 62-20

This correspondence is in reference to Jackson County Request for Proposal 62-20, a twelve month term & supply contract to furnish vehicle rental services for use by various County Departments to include the Jackson County Drug Task Force.

The Jackson County Drug Task Force currently lease ten (10) vehicles from Enterprise Rent-A-Car. These vehicles are used for covert surveillance and undercover operations in narcotics investigations.

Because of the nature of narcotics investigations and the need for officer safety it is critical detectives assigned to the Task Force have available a variety of types of vehicles to drive. And, on occasion, a vehicle must be changed on short notice if it is compromised.

Due to the rate increase the Task Force could expect to spend as much as \$150,000 in vehicle leases in 2021.

As Enterprise Rent-A-Car is the only company to respond to this Request for Proposal the Jackson County Drug Task Force would request that Enterprise Rent-A-Car be awarded the contract to furnish vehicle rentals for the Jackson County Drug Task Force.
