SECOND ADDENDUM TO LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

(Miller Matter)

THIS SECOND ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this 30 day of February, 2021, by and between JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, hereinafter called "the County" and SEYFERTH, BLUMENTHAL & HARRIS, 4801 Main Street Ste. 310, Kansas City, MO 64112 (hereinafter called "Special Counsel").

WHEREAS, The County and Legal Counsel previously entered into a Legal Services Agreement dated April 26, 2019 ("the Prior Agreement"), whereunder Legal Counsel agreed to provide specialized legal advice, assistance, and representation to the County relating to an employment case styled *Teesha Miller v. Jackson County, Missouri* – Case No. 1816-CV28965, and;

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to extend the Agreement for an additional twelve-months at no additional cost.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, County and Legal Counsel respectively promise, covenant and agree with each other as follows:

- Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the Legal Services Agreement dated April 26, 2019, and the previous addendum, between Legal Counsel and County shall remain in full force and effect.
- This Second Addendum to Agreement together with the Prior Agreement, and the previous addendum, shall be extended to December 31, 2021.
- 3. The Second Addendum shall be effective as of January 1, 2021, and shall remain in effect,



together with the Prior Agreement, and the previous addendum, until December 31, 2021.

4. This Second Addendum to Agreement together with the Prior Agreement, and the previous addendums, incorporates the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.
