REQUEST SUMMARY	On March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared a pandemic due to COVID-19.						
COMMITT	The United States government has approved multiple emergency relief packages to provide funds to Jackson County, other local governments, and citizens to meet unanticipated public health and economic needs caused by the pandemic.						
	The recent Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA) program makes available \$25 billion to assist households that are unable to pay rent and utilities due to the COVID-19 pandemic.						
	On January 26, 2021, the County received its allocation of Emergency Rental Assistance funds from the U.S. Treasury in the amount of \$11,550,205.						
	The County is to use the funds to provide assistance to eligible households through existing or newly created rental assistance programs. The County may only use the funds to provide financial assistance and housing stability services to eligible households. To be eligible, a household must be obligated to pay rent on a residential dwelling and the County must determine that:						
	1.One or more individuals within the household has qualified for unemployment benefits or experienced a reduction in household income, incurred significant costs, or experienced other financial hardship due, directly or indirectly, to the COVID-19 outbreak;						
	2.One or more individuals within the household can demonstrate a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability; and						
	3. The household has a household income at or below 80% of area median incor	ne.					

								
		In view of restrictions placed on the use of these Emergency Rental Assistance funds, it is appropriate that these funds be maintained in a separate and identified County special revenue fund and not commingled with the general or other special revenue funds of the County. The Legislature requests that the Administration establish a fund, by ordinance, as a separate special revenue fund of the County for the Emergency Rental Assistance funds, the monies of which shall not be commingled with the general revenue or any other special revenue of the County and the Administration shall propose a program plan, including the administration of the plan and an agency to administer the plan, for the intended use of the federal funds for approval by the Legislature.
