A resolution authorizing the County Prosecutor to execute an agreement, not to exceed \$2,621,107, with the Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners (KCPD), which are engaged in anti-crime and anti-violence law enforcement activities funded by the County's Anti-Crime Sales Tax Fund for the 2021 fiscal year.

Request Summary
A resolution authorizing the County Prosecutor to execute an agreement, not to exceed \$2,621,107, with the Kansas City Board of Police Commissioners (KCPD), which are engaged in anti-crime and anti-violence law enforcement activities funded by the County's Anti-Crime Sales Tax Fund for the 2021 fiscal year.
The KCPD, operating under the supervision of the Board of Police Commissioners, is the principal law enforcement agency serving Kansas City, Missouri. With its work in the prevention and investigation of crimes, and with its anti-violence programs, it assists in carrying out COMBAT's mission to assist in creating strong and safe communities, free from the dangers of illegal drugs and violent crime.
Funds for this agency (KCPD) are allocated by the Legislature adoption of the 2021 Budget (Ordinance 5461, Flr. Amendment, December 14, 2020).
