

- LAB REMAKES: SafeVision/ORR will replace any lab errors, if within 6 months of the invoice date and within the original invoice amount. More expensive replacements will be charged the price difference.
- EMPLOYEE PREFERENCE CHANGES: Changes due to employee preference are not warranty claims but will be accommodated. Employees must keep the normally billed first pair but will receive an employee paid 50% discount off the full price of the second pair; if within 2 months of the invoice date.
- RX CANCELLATIONS AND CHANGES: If lenses are not yet in process, prescription changes can be made at no charge. If lenses are already in process, a 50% credit will apply. If lenses have shipped, no cancellation credit will be given.

REPLACING LENSES UNDER WARRANTY

SafeVision will only permit licensed and/or trained eyecare professionals (ECPs)/ opticians to replace safety eyewear lenses. If an ECP requests safety lenses as replacements, PLEASE BE ADVISED OF THE FOLLOWING CAUTIONS. Insertion of safety lenses is considered part of the manufacturing process. As such, ECPs conducting this operation essentially become a manufacturer of safety eyewear, with the duties and responsibilities that apply. Lens fit can compromise the workers protection from impact. SafeVision requires circumference dimensions or the frame to trace when replacing lenses. It is the responsibility of those inserting lenses in safety fames to thoroughly check the fit of the lenses. The lenses should be snug and fit deeply in the groove. Any eyewire or lens movement can lead to potential injury. The frame must also be inspected for any damage or weakness from previous use. Frames over 2 years old shall be replaced, at the employee's expense, with new frames since the integrity and strength cannot be assured. Discontinued frames must be less than 2 years old and must be sent to the lab for tracing.

USER SUPPLIED FRAMES

SafeVision/ORR will not warrant a lab breakage of a previously used, employee supplied, frame.

AWAITING REPLACEMENT EYEWEAR

Employees waiting for their replacement safety eyewear should consult their company for recommended temporary eye protection. Damaged frames or lenses should not be worn in the workplace as they can compromise the safety of the employee. Any warranty replacement claim should be made through Customer Excellence Center at 800-982-2828. A Return Material Authorization (RMA) number will be assigned.
