Appropriating \$540,877 from the Anti-Crime Sales Tax Undesignated Fund and authorizing \$1,475,870 to execute agreements with certain outside agencies that provide youth employment programs and programs that provide essential services for domestic violence and sexual assault survivors at an aggregate cost to the County not to exceed \$2,016,747.

Request Summary

On April 4, 2021, COMBAT informed the public, through its website and social media posts, and by email blasts, of its intent to accept applications for its 2021 mid-year funding opportunity to fund anti-violence programs focusing on youth employment and domestic violence. The application deadline was 4:00 p.m. on April 23rd. Applications were accepted online made accessible through the COMBAT website. COMBAT received 26 applications, and 24 were recommended for funding. All agencies Isited in the attached list submitted proposals in response to the online solicitation by the deadline, with the required documents properly submitted and vetted in the application process.

Funding recommendations were presented to the Jackson County COMBAT Commission on May 10, 2021, with the recommendation that the funding recommendations listed in the attached document be presented to the Jackson County Legislature.
