AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF RAYTOWN, MISSOURI AND JACKSON COUNTY

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this day of 2021, by and between the City of Raytown, Missouri, municipal corporation and city of the fourth class of the state of Missouri (the "City") and the Jackson County, a Constitutional Home Rule Charter County in the State of Missouri, (the "County").

WHEREAS, the County owns a 2002 Cadillac Escalade (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the County desires to donate the Property to the City at no charge and the City desires to accept the transfer; and

WHEREAS, the City's police department intends to use the Property in order to further the goals of the police department in providing and maintaining a safe community; and

WHEREAS, the County and City desire to enter into an agreement providing for the transfer of the Property from the County to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein, the City and the County agree as follows:

- 1. The County agrees to transfer the Property to the City on an "as is" basis and at no cost to the City. The City agrees to accept the Property on an "as is" basis and the City is not responsible for any County obligations regarding the Property. Further, the Property is being donated to the City free and clear of any restrictions.
- 2. The County and the City agree that Property will be utilized to protect and serve the citizens of the City.
- 3. The County and the City agree that if the Board of Aldermen, in its sole discretion, determines that the Property should be surplus and sold, the Property may then be
- 4. The County and the City agree that the terms of this Agreement shall not be construed to place any limitation on the ability of the City to transfer the Property in any manner that the Board of Aldermen, in its sole discretion, may determine.
- 5. This Agreement constitutes the complete agreement of the County and the City and supercedes any discussions, representations, or proposals, written or oral.

<u>SECTION 2 – AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE.</u> The City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to this transaction and the City Clerk is authorized to attest to the same.

<u>SECTION 3 – REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY CLAUSE.</u> The provisions of this ordinance are severable and if any provision hereof is declared invalid, unconstitutional or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.

<u>SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVE DATE.</u> This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
