### 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, congratulated Virginia Molino upon her retirement and wished her well.

She called to the attention of the Legislature an article in the Kansas City Star, on the front page of the Metro Section regarding the Jackson County Land Trust. The Land Trust was surrounded by controversy for quite some time and the article shows how far the board has come and how much further it will go. The progress is a result of the outstanding work of the board and by the County's appointee, Michael O'Flaherty.

She reported good news in the recording of deeds in Jackson County. It is the County's policy to maintain a turnaround time of 7 business days. She reported that currently all documents brought into the Records Department are processed and returned within 4 business days. For comparison, she gave examples of other counties: Clay County has a 7-10 day turnaround, but they also have a lower volume; St. Louis County has a 4 week turnaround; and St. Charles County has a 94 day turnaround. She congratulated the employees and the Director of the Records Department for their commitment to quality and good customer service. She also thanked the Legislature for their support of the Administration and of the Records Department in helping make necessary changes and upgrading positions in the department. She said she was certain that the title companies and citizens echo her thanks.

Katheryn Shields announced the Parks Department will be hosting Jackson County's 5th annual Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday, March 23 at 10 A.M. at Lake Jacomo. Registration is \$5.00 per child and she encouraged anyone with children to participate. For additional information on this event, please contact the Parks Department at (816)795-8200.
