Dan Tarwater III, Chairman, called the meeting of the Jackson County Legislature to order.

3 APPROVAL OF THE JOURNAL OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

A motion was made by Crystal Williams, seconded by Theresa Galvin to approve the journal of the previous meeting held on June 01, 2015. The motion passed by a voice vote.

4 HEARINGS

Fred Dreiling, lobbyist, gave a bill report to the County Legislature. He summarized State legislation that passed, namely the right to work issue and House Bill 799 which transferred Division 12 in the 16th Judicial Circuit from Kansas City to the City of Independence. He also mentioned legislation that failed such as ethics reform, medicaid expansion, voter identification act, transportation funding and 9-1-1 funding.

Scott Burnett, County Legislator, asked Mr. Dreiling to explain the kill switch legislation. Fred Dreiling explained that this legislation was not pursued this year because an application should be available this summer. Kill switch legislation would require all smartphones to have a feature known as kill switch, which allows users to remotely wipe the contents of their phones and make them unusable if they get stolen. If the application is not released this summer, legislation will be introduced next session.

Dan Tarwater, Chairman, thanked Mr. Dreiling for his report and encouraged legislators to meet with the lobbyist on issues of interest for next year.
