5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Crystal Williams offered personal condolences to Dan Tarwater III and his family for the loss of his brother Brian Tarwater.

Frank White Jr., County Executive, read the following statement: Since we first learned of this horrible crime, our focus remains and will continue to remain on these victims and the safety of all those within our care. That being said, at this time these incidents remain under investigation and we have been asked not to comment on any specifics until those investigations have been completed. We have and will continue to cooperate with the Kansas City Police Department, Jackson County Prosecutor's Office, and former United States' Attorney General Todd Graves as their investigations move forward. All parties that were responsible for these incidents will be held accountable. In addition, I have asked the Director of the Department of Corrections to briefly

introduce two recent hires.

Joe Piccinini, Director of Department of Corrections, said a while back a group of dedicated people got together and established the Jail Task Force. The Jail Task Force then issued a list of recommendations in the Jail Task Force Report. Associates at the jail have been working diligently to follow through with their recommendations. The two new hires are examples of reaching goals set forth by the Jail Task Force. He introduced the first new hire, Major James Eickhoff, who will serve as a Major in Corrections over jail operations. Mr. Eickhoff has more than 25 years of operational experience, serving as a major for the last seven. The second new hire, Steven Raines, will serve as the new Accreditation Manager for the Detention Center. He is a proven leader with nearly 30 years of corrections experience, who most recently served as Assistant Warden for the U.S. Army Disciplinary Barracks at Fort Leavenworth.
