#### 4 HEARINGS

Colonel Ben Kenney, Undersheriff, presented a Letter of Commendation to Deputy Kreig Jarnigan for his quick actions in providing CPR to revive James West.

Jean Peters Baker, Prosecuting Attorney, gave a presentation regarding Kansas City No Violence Alliance (KC NoVA). She distributed two handouts: Homicide totals in U.S. Cities (2014-2016) and Murder Rate of the Top Cities in Murder Per 100,000 Residents. She explained programs such as Teens in Transition which will be launched in August 2017 and the Gun Intelligence Center.

She said KC NoVA is now located outside of the Prosecuting Attorney's office and they have morning briefings every day to discuss crimes committed. The U.S. Attorney's office also attends these briefings. The U.S. Department of Justice will come to Kansas City, Missouri to evaluate NoVA and suggest improvements.

She explained that the Center for Conflict Resolution is a group having expertise working with adults and youth and teaching them how to resolve conflicts without weapons.
