3 APPROVAL OF THE JOURNAL OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

A motion was made by Dan Tarwater III, seconded by Crystal Williams to approve the journal of the previous meeting held on June 27, 2017. The motion passed by a voice vote.

5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Frank White, Jr., County Executive, said two prominent Kansas Citians passed over the weekend, James B. Nutter Sr., founder of home mortgage company (James B. Nutter and Company) and Neal Patterson, CEO of Cerner Corporation.

Crystal Williams, County Legislator, asked the County Executive about the incident that happened at the jail over the weekend when a guard was assaulted by an inmate. She said again she learned of this incident through the media and not from the Administration.

Frank White, Jr., County Executive, responded that usually Gary Panethiere, Chief Operating Officer, contacts the Chair of the County Legislature, but he was on vacation so that did not happen this time. He

said since Joe Piccinini became the Director of Corrections he has tried to make things more transparent which is why we are hearing about more incidents at the jail. They are working hard daily to ensure safety for the associates and the inmates at the jail.

Crystal Williams said the Administration needs to be talking publicly about the positive things happening at the jail.

Frank White, Jr., said his goal is to show the improvements since 2015 until the HOK study is complete and put them up on Jackson County's website so the public can see before and after pictures documenting the improvements at the jail.

Dan Tarwater III, County Legislator, asked if the County Executive would be opposed to having sheriff deputies present at the jail for awhile, to see if law enforcement presence will make a difference.

Frank White, Jr., said he does not believe that is necessary at this time because correction officers must follow specific procedures. He suggested that the County Legislators attend graduations of the correction officers and talk to them about their responsibilites and let them know they are important and appreciated.

Scott Burnett said he has been speaking to Jim Rowenhorst, CRA Audit Consultant who indicated some of the management team at the jail are top notch.

Frank White, Jr., said his goal is to get the jail accredited again.

Dan Tarwater III said the newspaper suggests home monitoring and he wants the public to know that we currently have home monitoring but some inmates do not qualify.

Frank White, Jr., said Jackson County does not determine the jail population they just manage it.

Dan Tarwater III and Frank White, Jr. both agreed that the Kansas City Star has printed many incorrect articles.

Crystal Williams said she would love to attend graduation of the correction officers but has never been advised or invited to this event.

Frank White, Jr., said his associates will let the County Legislature know the specifics of the next graduation.

Discussion.

Scott Burnett shared that seven years ago today (July 10, 2010) James B. Nutter Sr. dedicated Ivanhoe Park.
