5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Frank White Jr., County Executive, said HOK was asked to take a thorough and honest look at our detention facilities and not to hold back on their findings. Thanks to their hard work, we now have a detailed and clear picture of where we stand in order to make informed and responsible decisions moving forward.

He said at the time of a 2015 Task Force study, entry pay for Jackson County corrections officers was 38% below the market rate. We reduced that gap last year with a new pay structure and today, for the first time, our proposal for entry pay would put our associates in line with the market rate, thus closing that gap.

Gary Panethiere, Chief Operating Officer, introduced Dennis Dumovich, Director of Human Resources, to discuss recommendations for attracting and retaining correction officers at the detention center.

Dennis Dumovich gave a presentation on the Jackson County Department of Corrections Retention Considerations and Recommendations dated September 5, 2017.

Joe Piccinini, Director of Corrections, gave a staffing report indicating how many corrections officers were needed for each shift. He said they currently have a bid out for a private company to transport inmates.

Discussion.

Mark Trosen, Deputy Chief Operating Officer, said Resolution #19485 awarded a contract to Hellmuth, Obata, and Kassabaum (HOK) Inc. for a facility condition assessment study of the four buildings of the Corrections Complex located at 1305 Locust, 1315 Locust, Jail Annex and the Main Tower at 1300 Cherry.

Jeff Bradley, Vice President/Director of Justice and Sonya Jury, Senior Associate/Senior Project Manager with HOK, gave a presentation on the Facility Condition Assessment of the Jail.
