Discussion regarding veto messages for Ordinances #5037 and #5038, COMBAT Executive Director, COMBAT tax, Jackson County's relationship with Kansas City Police Department and the regional corrections facility, bonds for the jail, County Executive press conference regarding the jail task force, firing versus resignation and counsel for the County Legislature.

Scott Burnett asked the County Executive to meet with the County Legislature next week regarding the jail task force and the regional corrections center.

The County Legislature voted to override the County Executive's veto of Ordinance #5038 at this time. See above for details.

Stephen Nixon, County Counselor, stated that as County Counselor he is a charter officer of Jackson County, Missouri and required to do what the charter outlines. One of the things not contained in the charter is that he works for the County Executive or the County Legislature. He is an independent county officer. He is required to give proper advice and render opinions he thinks correct under the law and under the charter, which is what he has done and will continue to do.

Dan Tarwater III, County Legislator, said a few weeks ago the County Legislature passed legislation with regards to Workmen's Compensation and a third party administrator. He said additional staff was to be placed in Risk Management and he would like an update on this matter.

Stephen Nixon, County Counselor, said he will give an update to the County Legislature at the legislative meeting scheduled to be held on Monday, November 20, 2017.

Scott Burnett said the County Legislature is discussing whether or not they will have a legislative meeting the week after Thanksgiving. He also said the budget hearings are tentatively set for December 4th and 5th.
