13 UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Veto of Ordinance #5069 was received in the County Clerk's Office on January 26, 2018. Dan Tarwater III, County Legislator, stated that the County Executive's message requested sufficient time for the County Counselor and its recently hired legal advisor, to fully research and draft legal opinions on this Ordinance. DanTarwater III stated that he was not opposed to giving the County Counselor the requested time. Dan Tarwater III asked Steve Nixon, County Counselor, if he had a conflict regarding rendering an opinion on this matter. Steve Nixon stated that there was no conflict by his office regarding giving an opinion on a specific ordinance if there is no litigation regarding that ordinance, but if the ordinance is litigated, then he would have a conflict.

Crystal Williams, County Legislator, stated that paragraph four of the veto message was confusing and she asked what that paragraph means.

Steve Nixon stated that he will consider the statements in the veto message in forming his legal opinion. Steve Nixon then stated that historically veto overrides have occurred at the next meeting of the legislature and if a vote to override does not occur at this meeting, it may be considered out of time. Dennis Waits, County Legislator, stated that he recommended that the legislature recess rather than adjourn so that this matter might be taken up at the February 5, 2018 meeting.

Greg Grounds, County Legislator, stated that the lack of clarity in the Charter as to the time limit to override a veto is another reason the Charter needs to be amended.
