14 NEW BUSINESS

Scott Burnett, Chairman, recognized Greg Grounds, County Legislator, to present information related to the Jackson County Charter. Greg Grounds stated that he had discussed the issue of introducing an ordinance to amend the Jackson County Charter with the Prosecuting Attorney and the Sheriff. He stated that it was his goal to get an ordinance adopted in time for this matter to be placed on the August ballot. He stated that to do this would require the Legislature to adopt such an ordinance by mid-May of this year.

He stated that his proposed changes to the Charter included: establishing term limits of two four-year terms for the County Executive and Legislature that would be effective January 1, 2019, clarify certain ambiguous sections of the Charter, designate the Sheriff to have management and control of the County jail, change the procedure for appointment of the County Counselor, designate the Prosecuting Attorney to have exclusive oversight, supervision, and contracting power of the COMBAT tax, and reduce the the size of the Jackson County Legislature to eight members, thereby eliminating one at-large district.

Crystal Williams, County Legislator, stated that she appreciates Greg Ground's passion regarding this topic. She stated that she is interested in making changes to the Charter but is concerned about the timeline and the ability to accomplish such changes by the May deadline. She stated that some of these recommendations will have a major impact on the representation of the citizens of Jackson County and that she believes this issue requires input from the citizens of the County. She stated that it is her desire to equalize the power between the County Executive and the County Legislature. She believes that more discussion needs to take place before this issue should be placed on the ballot.

Tony Miller, County Legislator, questioned whether a Charter Review Commission should be established. Greg Grounds stated that he believes going through the process of establishing a commission will delay the matter, whereas an ordinance on the weekly agenda would offer a quicker result. Greg Grounds stated that a copy of his recommendations would be available for the media and copies may also be obtained from the County Clerk's Office.

The County Legislature went into closed session.

The County Legislature reconvened.

Resolution #19760 was adopted at this time. See page 6 for details.
