Scott Burnett, Chairman, called the meeting of the Jackson County Legislature to order.

3 APPROVAL OF THE JOURNAL OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

A motion was made by Dan Tarwater III, seconded by Crystal Williams to approve the journal of the previous meeting held on April 02, 2018. The motion passed by a voice vote.

4 HEARINGS

Dianne Cleaver, President and CEO of the Urban Neighborhood Initiative, and Ted Anderson, Executive Director of the Kansas City Land Bank, spoke regarding problems related to purchasers obtaining a clear title for properties purchased through the tax sale foreclosure process. Ms. Cleaver stated that current state law is out-of-date and, while the County abides by the state law requirements, title insurance companies do not consider that process sufficient to issue a clear title.

A coalition of representatives from Jackson County, Legal Aid, the City of Kansas City, and the Kansas City Land Bank, as well as other neighborhood community groups, have been in discussions regarding solutions to the problem of obtaining clear title for properties that are in the Jackson County Delinquent Land Tax Foreclosure Sale.

Jackson County Courthouse 415 E.12th Street, 2nd floor Kansas City, Missouri 64106 (816)881-3242 *Mr.* Anderson stated that one solution would be to change state law, but there could be unintended consequences to such a change. He stated that a simpler solution may be to revise the County Code to require a formal title search report for properties in the tax sale so that all interested parties receive personal notice of the tax delinquency. This proposal will come at a significant cost. The City and the Land Bank recommend a pilot project that would cover obtaining a title report and service on approximately 562 properties that presently have a delinquency between \$3,000 and \$20,000. The estimated cost for this pilot project is \$500,000 with the cost being evenly split between the City of Kansas City and Jackson County, Missouri.

Scott Burnett, Chairman, requested information on the cost-benefit analysis of such a pilot project. Crystal Williams, County Legislator, expressed support for moving forward in the next step in this process.
