Authorizing the County Executive and the Prosecuting Attorney to execute an Agreement to Extend the Memorandum of Understanding with Local Union No. 42 of the International Association of Fire Fighters through November 15, 2018.

<u>19958</u>	Awarding a twelve-month term and supply contract, with two twelve month options to extend for the furnishing of online payment processing services for use by the Collections Department to UMB Bank of Kansas City, MO, as a sole source purchase.  (Assigned to the Finance and Audit Committee.)
<u>19959</u>	Declaring certain property within various County departments as surplus and unusable personal property and authorizing its disposal.  (Assigned to the Finance and Audit Committee.)
<u>19960</u>	Partially rescinding Resolution 19849, dated April 30, 2018, that authorized agreements with certain agencies for the furnishing of anti-drug and anti-violent crime prevention activities.  (Assigned to the Anti-Drug Committee.)
<u>19961</u>	Transferring \$56,141.00 within the 2018 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund to cover the second portion of funds allocated for the Sheriff's Office's 2018 Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) program.  (Assigned to the Anti-Drug Committee.)
<u>19962</u>	Authorizing the County Executive to execute an amendment to the Program Agreement with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for a tracking program for statistical reporting of opioid and violent deaths, for a fee payable to the County.  (Assigned to the Health and Environment Committee.)
<u>19963</u>	Transferring \$20,000.00 within the 2018 Special Road and Bridge Fund to cover the cost of wearing apparel for use by the Sheriff's Office.  (Assigned to the Justice and Law Enforcement Committee.)
<u>19964</u>	Authorizing the County Executive to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services relating to Enhanced Opioid Surveillance Toxicology Testing to receive grant funds. (Assigned to the Health and Environment Committee.)  Scott Burnett resumed the Chair.
<u>19965</u>	Expressing the intent of the Legislature that Jackson County reverse all prior voluntary reductions of property tax rates.  (Assigned to the Legislature As A Whole.)
	Greg Grounds, County Legislator, asked Frank White, Jr., County Executive, if he supports Resolution #19965. Mr. White stated that he does support the resolution.

Jay Haden, Chief Deputy County Counselor, stated that Resolution #19965 needs a public hearing.

Ed Stoll, Chief Administrative Officer, said that if this resolution is adopted it will need to be sent to the State Auditor's Office before the introduction of the tax levy ordinances. Those ordinances will also require public hearings, creating a narrow time frame to accomplish all that is required by state law.

Scott Burnett, Chair, announced that a meeting will be held on Wednesday, September 5, 2018 at 11:00 A.M. in the Kansas City Legislative Assembly Area to hold a public hearing and discussion on Resolution #19965.
