Scott Burnett, Chairman, called the meeting of the Jackson County Legislature to order.

3 APPROVAL OF THE JOURNAL OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

A motion was made by Dan Tarwater III, seconded by Dennis Waits to approve the journal of the previous meeting held on October 22, 2018. The motion passed by a voice vote.

4 HEARINGS

Theresa Galvin, County Legislator, welcomed representatives from First Call Alcohol and Drug Prevention. Susan Whitmore, President and CEO, Ben Schloegel, volunteer, and Dale Gray, Chief Information Officer, presented information about its project regarding the availability of opioid addiction services in the Kansas City metropolitan area.

Mr. Schloegel reported that First Call's audit of social services within the area found 800 different agencies addressing this matter. Opioid addiction impacts all segments of our community. Scott Burnett, County Legislator, asked for a further explanation of MAT, Medication Assisted Treatment. Mr. Schloegel said that one of the biggest problems in the area of addiction treatment is the stigma against people on medication for treatment of their addiction. These treatments, such as methadone, will cause the client to continue to test positive for drug use and many programs will not accept clients for treatment under such protocols.

Crystal Williams, County Legislator, questioned the availability of treatment options for persons in Missouri that receive health benefits through Medicaid. Susan Whitmore agreed that this is a particular problem in Missouri because Missouri Medicaid has not been expanded to cover the costs of addiction treatment. The handout presented by First Call is available in the Clerk of the County Legislature's Office.
