## 3 APPROVAL OF THE JOURNAL OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

A motion was made by Dan Tarwater III, seconded by Jeanie Lauer to approve the journal of the previous meeting held on August 26, 2019. The motion passed by a voice vote.

### 4 HEARINGS

Theresa Galvin, Chair, invited Presiding Judge David Byrn to give an update. Judge Byrn said that the downtown Jackson County Courthouse infrastructure is crumbling. He reported that there was another leak in pipes that affected the courts. Judge Byrn explained that the pipe system in the courthouse has a lifespan of 50 years and is now 80 to 85 years old. He said that it is a matter of time before the pipes fail again unless something is done on a grander scale, such as exploring whether the entire pipe system should be replaced. He questioned whether it is an efficient use of taxpayer dollars to put a bandaid on problems rather than properly maintaining the facility.

Discussion.

Brian Gaddie, Director of Public Works, said that prior to his tenure with the County the course of action was a reactive plan, rather than a proactive

plan. His goal is to be proactive with solutions to our infrastructure issues. He said he will provide the Legislature a future plan of what he believes needs to be addressed.
