4 HEARINGS

Brian Gaddie, Director of Public Works, introduced Troy Nash and Rick Davidson of JCDC Partners, LLC for an update on the Owner's Representative project. Mr. Davidson said that they were given a notice to proceed on January 6, 2020. They held a kick-off meeting to introduce the core JCDC members to the key Jackson County parties that will form the initial steering committee, made up of Chairman Theresa Galvin, County Executive Frank White, Presiding Judge David Byrn, Sheriff Darryl Forte', and Prosecuting Attorney Jean Peters Baker. This Steering Committee will give input on the direction of the project in this initial phase. In this phase of the project, Mr. Davidson said, they will be reviewing prior studies and building on the previous work. In the kick-off meeting they presented a preliminary work plan and set out the key dates. The group developed a mission statement to clearly identify what they will achieve. The County Administrator is reaching out to other municipalities to receive their input. Over the next six weeks they will be gathering pertinent data and meeting with jail personnel to assess the policies and practices of the current jail administration. The next update will be presented on March 9, 2020.
