Theresa Cass Galvin, Chairman, called the meeting of the Jackson County Legislature to order.

#### 3 APPROVAL OF THE JOURNAL OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

A motion was made by Dan Tarwater III, seconded by Scott Burnett to approve the journal of the previous meeting held on August 03, 2020. The motion passed by a voice vote.

#### 4 HEARINGS

Brian Gaddie, Director of Public Works, introduced the JCDC Partners, LLC team; Dr. Troy Nash and Babette Macy were in attendance, Karl Becker, Wendy Ware, Chloe Jaco, and Rick Davidson attended online via TEAMS.

Dr. Troy Nash said he had seven points related to his update. 1.) Their team continues to work remotely but is on schedule and participation is robust. 2.) The MBE/WBE goals update is going well. They continue to meet the County's goals and compliance. 3.) The validation of need is completed and was presented on July 13, 2020. It is available online at www.jcdetentioncenter.com. 4.) The programming phase of the project continues on schedule. JCDC Partners is preparing a draft document on this phase to be presented to the steering committee on August 18, 2020. User group planning sessions have been completed. The planning committee conducted 36 separate planning sessions. Participation has been outstanding. 5.) Benchmarking workshops continue as a way of promoting best practices and lessons learned from other jurisdictions. These enhance the programming session. The first session was in Maricopa County, Arizona and focused on best practices for detainee processing. The second session in San Mateo, California, focused on flexible detainee housing options. Session three related to medical and mental health within jails focused on best ways to provide services. 6.) The communication's plan began this month which included a meeting with stakeholders to brief them on the programming phase of the project. The project website is live. This included meetings with the Sheriff's Office staff and the Kansas City Police Department leadership. 7.) Finally, a review of the schedule has been handed out. Dr. Nash highlighted three points, first, they remain on schedule, second, JCDC will present programming documents on September 28, 2020 and third the next component stage of the process needs to be authorized by the County Legislature in the month of August to remain on schedule. The next stage will build upon work completed including the owner's design criteria, design build contract requirements and RFQ and RFP, and site selection criteria.

Ronald E. Finley, County Legislator, asked Brian Gaddie if Jackson County is receiving itemized monthly billings and asked if he could make them available.

*Mr.* Gaddie responded yes we are receiving monthly bills and he will provide copies to Mr. Finley.

Dan Tarwater III, County Legislator, asked Brian Gaddie if the statue of Andrew Jackson would be cleaned.

Brian Gaddie said his associates will be cleaning the statue on Thursday, August 13, 2020.
