14 NEW BUSINESS

Scott Burnett, County Legislator, said a constituent called to ask if the County's parcel viewer is down. When he followed up, the constituent said the City of Kansas City informed him a new state law requires property requests to be in the form of a Sunshine request. Troy Schulte said the parcel viewer was working as of last week. They continue to have technical issues accessing Ascend Web. Bryan Covinsky, County Counselor, said he is not familiar with any changes to law regarding Sunshine requests. Tony Miller, County Legislator, said he agrees with Mr. Burnett as to the problems accessing Ascend online. Tony Miller said he received a message from someone listening online that Ascend Web works using Firefox, but not Chrome.

Jalen Anderson thanked Legislators Dan Tarwater III, Tony Miller, and Chief of Staff, Caleb Clifford, and Winifred Jamieson from County Legislator Crystal Williams's office, for attending the town hall meeting with Heart Mobile Village tenants. He said there are things the County must do better to make sure these concerns are addressed. Dan Tarwater III said Legislators assured tenants that their request to have everything in writing will be completed by the Administration this week. Tony Miller said he took notes and would send a summary to Legislators The key requests were for transparency, uniformity, and communication. The Legislature recessed for the closed meeting per Resolution #20792.
