WHEREAS, by Resolution 11294, dated May 13, 1996, the Legislature did authorize the County to provide funding to all municipalities in Jackson County whose police departments sponsor Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) or similar anti-drug programs; and,

WHEREAS, there are additional monies appropriated for DARE in 1996 that have remained unencumbered pending resolution of an issue question regarding allocation of funds; and,

WHEREAS, all outstanding issues have been resolved and it is now the recommendation of the COMBAT Commission that the same municipalities receive an allocation under the same funding formula as used under Resolution 11294, in the amounts shown below: MUNICIPALITY **ALLOCATION**
