ORDINANCE 3134, March 5, 2001

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Zoning Order of Jackson County, Missouri, and the official maps which are a part thereof, are amended by changing the boundaries of the "A" (Agricultural) District and the "PR" (Posidential Panchette) District so that there will be transferred from District A to District RP

"RR" (Residential Ranchette) District so that there will be transferred from District A to District RR a tract of land described as follows:
