WHEREAS, Will served a dual position with the Parks and Recreation Department as the Assistant Director and as the Acting Superintendent of Natural Resources; and,

WHEREAS, Will gained the respect and admiration of colleagues for his hard work and meritorious service in enhancing and preserving the natural resources of the Jackson County lakes and parks; and,

WHEREAS, Will Staller has been a great asset to the Jackson County Parks and Recreation Department and will be greatly missed; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature commends Will Staller for his dedication and distinguished career with the Jackson County Parks and Recreation Department for the past thirty-five (35) years, and wishes him success and happiness in his retirement.
