WHEREAS, the Office of the Clerk of the County Legislature has a need for maintenance and support for its proprietary Granicus software; and,

WHEREAS, the Clerk's Office currently uses Granicus Encoding, Open Platform Suite, and Meeting Efficiency Suite for Legislative meetings; and,

WHEREAS, the Clerk's Office has a need to upgrade its proprietary encoder appliance hardware and

software at the County Legislature's Independence location; and,

WHEREAS, the required annual maintenance agreement supports these critical applications

necessary for County business; and,

WHEREAS, annual software maintenance agreements are considered sole source purchases, as the

maintenance can only be provided by the software's developer; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1030.1 of the <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, the Director of Finance

and Purchasing and Clerk recommend the award of a contract for software maintenance and support

for use by the Office of the Clerk of the County Legislature to Granicus of St. Paul, MN, at an actual

cost to the County in the amount of \$7,653.00 for 2024, as a sole source purchase; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that award be made as

recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing and Clerk of the County Legislature, and

that the Director be and hereby is authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary for

the accomplishment of the award; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing is authorized to make all

payments, including final payment, on the contract.
