INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Director of Purchasing pursuant to Section 1040.05 of the Jackson County Code, 1984, recommends the purchase of automotive batteries, for use by the Parks and Recreation Department, under Bid No. PA3884, an existing government contract of the City of Kansas City, Missouri; and,

WHEREAS, Section 1064.00, Jackson County Code, 1984, requires that, for any such purchase in excess of \$5,000, the Director of Purchasing shall submit the purchase to the County Legislature for approval; therefore,
