**ORDINANCE** # **3257**, May 28, 2002

**INTRODUCED BY** Terry Young, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the County has owned Tarsney Lake, Wood Lake and other common areas in the Tarsney Lakes community since the Village of Tarsney Lakes was disincorporated in 1984; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County that swimming and boating on these lakes be regulated; now therefore,

Section A. <u>Enacting Clause</u>. Sections 5561. and 5562., <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, are hereby enacted, to read as follows:
