A RESOLUTION authorizing the County Executive to execute an Easement Agreement with Laidlaw Waste Systems (Kansas City), Inc. RESOLUTION # 11984, December 15, 1997

INTRODUCED BY Fred Arbanas, County Legislator

WHEREAS, Jackson County owns the Blue River Parkway in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri, adjacent to the Blue River and the Southeast Sanitary landfill; and,

WHEREAS, Laidlaw Waste Systems (Kansas City), Inc. owns certain real estate adjacent to the Blue River Parkway, and has requested an easement for the construction and maintenance of ground water and gas monitoring equipment on the County's property; and,

WHEREAS, it will benefit the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Jackson County to have the proposed equipment built and maintained upon the County's property; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute an easement agreement with Laidlaw Waste Systems (Kansas City), Inc., to carry out the above stated purposes in a form substantially similar to that attached...Attorney
