ORDINANCE NO. 4710, December 15, 2014

INTRODUCED BY Scott Burnett and Dan Tarwater, County Legislators

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Enacting Clause. Schedules II and III to Chapter 2, <u>Jackson County</u>, 1984, are hereby repealed, and two new schedules enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as Schedules II and III, to read as follows:
