WHEREAS, the City of Kansas City has been notified that it has been awarded a Local Law Enforcement Block Grant by the United States Department of Justice; and,

WHEREAS, the City has proposed to pass-through a portion of the grant's proceeds to the County for use in on-site drug testing which will be bid out as part of the County's anti-drug programs; and,

WHEREAS, the City has requested that the attached Cooperative Agreements be executed to provide a mechanism by which these funds can be turned over to the County; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation from the unappropriated surplus of the 1998 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund:
