ORDINANCE #2573, August 12, 1996

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the County has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$75,000 plus the carry-over of \$48,608 from the Missouri Department of Mental Health to fund the County's Substance Abuse Traffic Offender's (SATOP) Program; and,

WHEREAS, this grant is subject to a \$24,561 local match plus the carry-over of \$7,329; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation from the unappropriated surplus of the 1996 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund is necessary to place the grant and matching funds in the proper accounts; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation be made from the unappropriated surplus of the 1996 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund:
