IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE setting the 2004 Jackson County, Missouri, tax levy.

ORDINANCE # 3540, September 13, 2004

INTRODUCED BY Ronald E. Finley, County Legislator

WHEREAS, chapter 5, section 540.00 of the <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984 requires the County Legislature to adopt a tax levy sufficient to provide for appropriations in the County budget; and,

WHEREAS, sections 137.073 and 137.115, RSMo 2000, and Missouri Constitution, article X section 22, require political subdivisions, including counties, to revise their tax levies as a result of general

reassessment; and,

WHEREAS, the 2004 annual County budget would require the following tax levies on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the fiscal year 2004 after calculation of the levy revision mandated by sections 137.073 and 137.115 and the Missouri Constitution:

LEVY

General \$0.2795

Health \$0.2588

Park \$0.1538 Special Road and Bridge \$0.2184

TOTAL \$0.9105

and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to authorization granted in sections 67.500 et seq., RSMo 2000, the qualified voters in Jackson County on November 6, 1979, approved Jackson County Proposition #1 which provided for a county-wide sales tax of one-half cent and a corresponding reduction of the County's total property tax levy annually by seventy percent of the total amount of sales tax revenue in the same tax year; and,

WHEREAS, section 67.505, RSMo 2000, requires that after a county has determined its budget, the total property tax levy must be reduced in an amount sufficient to decrease the total property taxes it will collect by an amount equal to 70% of the sales tax revenue in the same tax year; and,

WHEREAS, this estimate is subject to revisions based upon actual sales tax revenues during the calendar year of 2004, and the permanent levy adopted in September 2005, will reflect an adjustment based on actual sales tax revenues during the calendar year 2004; and,

WHEREAS, during the 2003 calendar year, the estimated sales tax revenues exceeded the 2003 actual sales tax revenues by \$1,877,415.64 and, therefore, the 2004 Jackson County tax levy must be adjusted to reflect this decrease from the 2003 estimated revenues; and,

WHEREAS, this adjustment is made by deducting the \$1,877,415.64 from the 2004 estimated sales tax revenues (\$41,456,313.42) to produce \$39,578,897.78, of which 70% is used to reduce the 2004 property tax levy; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri that, based upon estimates of the 2004 sales tax revenues, including the decrease in the actual sales tax revenues during 2003, based upon the appropriation in the 2004 annual County budget, and based upon the levy rollbacks required by law, the following amounts on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation be set as the Jackson County Tax Levy for the fiscal year 2004, on real and personal property within Jackson County, Missouri:

Health \$0.1600

Park \$0.0900 Special Road and Bridge \$0.1400
