WHEREAS, the Western District of Missouri Federal Drug Enforcement Agency has made an Equitable Sharing payment to the Jackson County Sheriff's Office in the amount of \$11,952.90; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place these funds in the proper spending accounts; and,
