INTRODUCED BY Terry Young, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Social Services, Division of Child Support Enforcement, has been delegated the responsibility for the development and administration of a statewide program to establish and enforce child support obligations; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 13340, the Division, the Circuit Court of Jackson County, and the County have proposed to enter into a cooperative agreement concerning child support enforcement in Jackson County, as authorized by § 454.405, RSMo; and,

WHEREAS, the Division, Court, and County also desire to establish a mechanism by which certain staff costs of the Court's Family Court Division can be reimbursed by the Division of Child Support
