AN ORDINANCE setting the 1997 merchants and manufacturers' inventory replacement tax levy.

ORDINANCE # 2720, September 2, 1997

INTRODUCED BY Victor E. Callahan, County Legislator

WHEREAS, Missouri Constitution, article X, section 6 and section 139.600, RSMo 1994, provide for a tax levy to be charged against the assessed valuation of real property listed in subclass 3 (utility, industrial, commercial and railroad property) of class one property (real estate), to replace revenues lost from the exemption of merchants' and manufacturers' inventories; and,

WHEREAS, this replacement levy has been calculated in accordance with section 139.600, RSMo 1994; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the 1997 replacement levy is \$1.437 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real property in subclass 3 of class one property...Attorney
