WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections has requested an upgrade of its present. Wireless

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Personal Data Terminals (PDTs) for inmate and pre-trial detainee processing; and,

WHEREAS, a total of three (3) solicitations were distributed and three (3) responses were received of which two (2) were determined to be "no bid". The following response was received:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1054.6 of the <u>Jackson County Code</u>, 1984, the Director of Purchasing recommends the award of a contract for the furnishing of Hardware, Installation, Training, Consulting and Maintenance to upgrade the current Wireless Personal Data Terminals (PDTs) for use by the Corrections Department to DataCapture Technologies, Inc., of Kansas City, MO as the lowest and best bidder under the terms and conditions of Request For Proposal No. 20-05; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Purchasing also recommends provision for a contingency in an aggregate total amount not to exceed \$30,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, a transfer of \$288,811.43 within the 2005 Anti Drug Sales Tax Fund is necessary to cover the cost of this purchase and the recommended contingency; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends said transfer; now therefore,
