RESOLUTION # 11373, July 29, 1996

INTRODUCED BY John C. Graham, County Legislator

WHEREAS, Public Water Supply District No. 17 has an existing watermain parallel to Stillhouse Road at the roadway crossing of an unnamed branch of Seminary Creek; and,

WHEREAS, the existing culvert on Stillhouse Road is narrow and structurally deficient and must be replaced; and,

WHEREAS, due to the design of the project, Public Water Supply District No. 17 and Jackson County have determined that it will be necessary to relocate a portion of the watermain, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$12,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, to effect this relocation, the County and Public Water Supply District No. 17 have negotiated the attached agreement; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri that the attached agreement is hereby approved, and that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute the attached agreement on behalf of the County; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Finance be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the Agreement...Attorney

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
