IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI

AN ORDINANCE setting the 1999 Jackson County, Missouri tentative tax levy.

ORDINANCE #2882, December 15, 1998

INTRODUCED BY Victor Callahan, County Legislator

WHEREAS, Section 539.00 of the Jackson County Code requires the County Legislature to adopt a tentative tax levy sufficient to provide for appropriations in the county budget; and,

WHEREAS, the 1999 annual county budget would require the following tax levies on each hundred dollars of assessed valuation for the fiscal year 1999:

FUND	LEVY
General Fund	\$0.28
Health Fund	0.27
Park Fund	0.16
Special Road & Bridge Fund	0.24

TOTAL ALL FUNDS \$0.95

and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to authorization granted by Sections 67.500 through .545, RSMo 1994, the qualified voters in Jackson County on November 6, 1979, approved Jackson County Proposition #1 which imposed a county-wide sales tax on one-half of one percent and required that the total county property tax levy be reduced by 70% of the total amount of the sales tax revenues in the tax year; and,

WHEREAS, Section 67.510, RSMo, requires that after the County has determined its budget, the total property tax levy must be reduced in an amount sufficient to decrease the total property taxes it will collect by an amount equal to 70% of the sales tax revenue in the same tax year; and,

WHEREAS, the tentative estimate of the sales tax revenues to be collected in 1999 is \$37,200,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, this tentative estimate is subject to revision based upon actual sales tax revenues during the first six months of 1999 and the permanent levy to be adopted in September, 1999, will reflect actual sales tax revenues during the first six months of 1999; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that based upon tentative estimates of the sales tax revenues in 1999 and based upon the appropriations in the 1999 annual county budget, the following amount on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation be set as the Jackson County Tentative Tax Levy for the fiscal year 1999 on Real and Personal Property within Jackson County, Missouri:

Health Fund	0.16
Park Fund	0.09
Special Road & Bridge Fund	0.14
TOTAL ALL FUNDS	\$0.56

Effective Date: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its signature by the County Executive.
