screening services for use by the Medical Examiner's Office to Children's Mercy Hospital of Kansas

City (Jackson County), MO, a tax-exempt organization; and,

WHEREAS, the Director recommends the procurement of these services from Children's Mercy

Hospital based on price, proximity, and the long-term relationship between the two organizations;

specific amount; now therefore,

payments, including final payment on the agreement, to the extent that sufficient appropriations to the

using spending agency are contained in the then current Jackson County budget.
