WHEREAS, the Fort Osage R-1 School District's "Truancy Prevention" program is designed to improve academic achievement by targeting students in grades K-9 that have mild to severe truancy problems, allowing for early intervention into school attendance problems, and providing an avenue for holding parents responsible for getting their children to school; and,

WHEREAS, the District has received a grant from the Missouri Local Investment Commission for the
program in the amount of \$258,018; and,
WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office recommends the execution of a Cooperative
Agreement with the Fort Osage School District, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$78,570.00,
which sum may serve as a portion of the required local matching funds for this program; now
therefore,
BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive
be and hereby is authorized to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Fort Osage R-1 School
District, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor; and,
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing is hereby authorized to
make all payments, including final payment on the agreement.
Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
